

The TOEIC test (Test of English for International Communication) is an English language proficiency test for people whose native language is not English. It measures the everyday English skills of people working in an international environment. The scores indicate how well people can communicate in English with others in business, commerce, and industry.

The TOEIC test is a two-hour multiple-choice test that consists of 200 questions divided into two sections:



Listening Section: The Listening Section tests how well you understand spoken English. It consists of four parts and contains 100 questions administered by CD. You will be asked to answer questions based on a variety of statements, questions, conversations and talks recorded in English.

Reading Section: The Reading section includes three parts, testing how well you understand written English. You will read a variety of materials and respond at your own pace to 100 questions based on the content of the materials provided to you.

Programme details

The TOEIC exam preparation programme includes two components:

- A self-study programme
- A self-study programme with one week preparation course (12 hours/week)

Before starting the programme, students sit a pre-test to assess their English language skills. They are then entered for their exam. Students receive a self-study package, containing Business English, grammar points, vocabulary and TOEIC test practice, with answers for self-marking.

One week before the exam, students can join morning classes to do exam practice and fine-tune their English skills.
