Entry Requirements

- Language proficiency: IELTS 5.5 with no band lower than 5.0 or equivalent to CEFR B2, and a language teaching qualification (e.g. Cert TESOL) or a local state qualification plus a minimum of 6 months teaching experience
- Language proficiency: IELTS 5.5 with no band lower than 5.0 or equivalent to CEFR B2, and at least 2 years teaching experience that allows for the completion of the assessment tasks to the level required

English Language Courses -12 + weeks

Information for all English Language Programmes

- Levels from Beginner/Elementary to Advanced
- Class hours are 9am to 3pm, Monday to Friday
- Full time and part time options are available (visa conditions allowing)
- Under 3 months, Visitor or Student Visa. Over 3 months, Student Visa
- Study on a Work or Working Holiday Visa (conditions may apply)
- Start any Monday (where possible)
- NZ work rights possible for students enrolled fulltime for 14 weeks plus
- EAS and NZCEL programmes are NZQA approved
- Study reading, writing, listening and speaking. EAS also teaches exam skills
- Long courses are NZQA registered and approved
- ETC is a Category One tertiary provider







Certificate in English for Academic Study (EAS)

Serious academic study. Reading, writing, listening, speaking, vocabulary and exam skills.

- For students who wish to learn English for further study or employment goals
- For students who wish to study toward external exams such as IELTS, CAE, LanguageCert etc.
- Elementary programmes are equivalent to CEFR A1- A2
- Intermediate programmes are equivalent to CEFR B1-B2 or IELTS 4.4 6.0
- Advanced programmes are equivalent to CEFR C1 C2 or IELTS 7.0 7.5
- Full time courses can be either 25 hours class time or 20 hours class time plus 5 hours self study per week (selected campuses)

New Zealand Certificate in English Language (NZCEL)

This qualification is intended for learners of English as an additional language who wish to increase their English language proficiency

- For students who wish to learn English for further study or employment goals
- Internally assessed with no external exams
- Levels Foundation, Level 1 and Level 2 are foundation programmes
- Levels 3 and 4 have General and Academic options. Level 4 Academic is equal to IELTS 6.0
- 20 week programmes start twice yearly—February and July









English Language Courses-Under 12 weeks

English Skills Short Study Course

For adult students who wish to learn English for personal development or fun!

- Short term study. 1 week to 3 calendar months
- Visitor visa
- Study at one or more campuses! E.g. two weeks in Auckland and two weeks in Palmerston North or Wellington









Pre-New Zealand High School Study Courses

For students who want extra English language support before starting at a New Zealand school

- English only or a mix of English and fun activities
- Age 14 years plus
- Twice a year before NZ High School intakes in January and July.
- ETC will work with your high school for accommodation and pastoral care needs.

High School Holiday Study Courses

For students who want extra English language support in the New Zealand school holidays

- English only or a mix of English and fun activities
- NZ High School holidays are four times a year (December/January, April, July, September/October)
- ETC will work with your high school for accommodation and pastoral care needs

High School English Support (after school)

For students who want extra English language support during the school term

- After school tuition 3.30 5pm
- Understand homework and develop English vocabulary as used in the classroom

- Minimum age 18 years old
- Visitor, Working Holiday or Student Visa
- Police Check
- Application and Letter of Introduction

Introduction to Care and Support Work

Foundation programme for students wanting a career in a care or medical facility

- Includes the NZQA approved New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing, Level 2
- Graduates can progress to levels 3 and 4
- Combine basic skills and knowledge with unpaid practical hands on experience
- Available at our Palmerston North campus only.
- 14 weeks duration.

Entry Criteria

- Minimum age 18 years old
- Pre-intermediate level of English (IELTS 5.0 or equivalent)
- Student Visa
- Police Check

English for Health Professionals

Primarily designed for overseas trained doctors, nurses, dentists and other health professionals who want to work in New Zealand and Australia.

- Full time academic study
- Additional one-to-one hours focusing on medical English

Entry Criteria

- Minimum age 18 years old
- Overall IELTS score of 6.0 with no score less than 5.5 or equivalent.
